RE-OPENING OF AHMADU BELLO UNIVERSITY, ZARIA

1. Since the students' crisis of September 27th and 28th, 2007, the Senate of the Ahmadu Bello University has held a series of meetings to deliberate on the crisis and find a way forward. In the latest of such meetings held on Tuesday, 18th December, 2007, the Senate met to deliberate on a resumption date.

Arising from the deliberations, members of the University Senate strongly condemned the action of the students for taking the law into their hands and in visiting such mayhem on the house of the Vice-Chancellor and Dean of Students Affairs of the University. Senate strongly reminded the students of the provisions of their matriculation oath, with implications for both character and learning.

2. Consequent upon this, the University Senate has approved that the University be re-opened on 21st January, 2008. However, all returning students are required to fulfill the following conditions before they are re-admitted as students of the University:

(b) Payment of N1,000.00 damage charges with any of the under listed Banks using the respective Account numbers. Students should come along with evidence of payment (i.e. Teller) to their respective Faculty Accountant's office for issuance of A.B.U. official receipt.
